Artificial Limb provided to Physically Challenged -Rangarajapuram

Our Beloved Bhagawan lovingly says "You should undertake service activities which benefit the physically challenged throughout their lives."

In line with Swami's message, Rangarajapuram Samithi has done a Unique Seva by providing an Artificial Limb to Sri. Thyagarajan, who has recently lost his leg.

Sri. Thyagarajan, aged about 50 years, is a Stapathi by profession and hails from Chidambaram district in Tamil Nadu. He lost his leg due to acute diabetes & approached Rangarajapuram Samithi for help in procuring a lightweight prosthetic leg. The members of the Samithi took it upon themselves - this noble Seva & made it possible by coordinating with the

services of an orthopedician & physiotherapist meticulously.




Gurus Spiritual Sadhana Camp

Special Article on Scribe Seva

Scribe Duty - A pride Seva to the society

Our Bhagawan says that "The End of Education is Character". But, that education becomes very challenging for the visually impaired. In order to help them, the scribing system was started in Chennai Metro South. This Seva is unique - to become the hands for those visually impaired persons who cannot see and write.

Initially, we started in the year 1997 with only 5 mahila members as scribes; by the course of time, and with Bhagawan's Grace, the number increased. At one point of time, there were 140 scribes which members included and members. During the tenure of then MetroWest DP - Sri. Balakrishnan, the scribe duty was done with the help of 5 scribes at The Little flower convent, on a trial basis.. Along with members, nonmembers were also encouraged to become scribes. With the notion that rendering service is an 'act of punyam' they accepted to become regular scribes. But as time went by, they became more involved in the Seva that some of them served for two consecutive sessions, not caring for their lunch time. The scribing service, which was meant for the 10th & 12th Students was later on extended to other students appearing for the Board exams.







It is said that "Appreciation is a wonderful thing. It makes what is excellent in others belong to us." A word of appreciation will do wonders. As a mark of showing our appreciation for the scribes, they were taken for a get-together, after the exams were over. Bio-data of the scribes was maintained to enable prompt and quick communication. Birthday wishes and other important days were taken into account and proper greetings were sent. This helped in maintaining a personal touch. A duty roaster was maintained in order to see that no scribe is overworked.

Our organisation is very particular about the dress code. Mahilas must come in sarees only. Some found it difficult. To put them at ease, they were given an exemption for two times. Later on, they themselves followed the dress code religiously. Some youth

members used to come by two-wheelers, for them Churidar is comfortable while driving. They used to bring sarees with them and change to sarees in a room provided by the School/College authorities.

By rendering this service, mahilas followed the 5 Ds automatically. They started doing this as an act of punyam because of Devotion. That led to Determination that is to take part in this service without fail; slowly, they learnt to discriminate the good from the bad, and felt committed to their Duty. Then comes the fifth D-Discipline imbibing which enabled them to be regular in their work.

The scribing service was extended to the students of Loyola College also. Since the number of students were more, the need for more scribes also arose. 140 mahilas serve as scribes at the rate of five sessions per day. One of the sevadals was so impressed by this service that even after leaving Chennai for Coimbatore, she started a scribing service, which reached out to many students. Her service was very much appreciated and awarded. Bhagawan used to stress that, only through sacrifice one can attain liberation. When rendering a particular service, one has to sacrifice his/her personal likes and dislikes, needs and comforts. For attaining that liberation, scribing paves the path.

To participate in scribe, kindly contact your nearby Samithi Service Coordinators.

In addition to scribing, our service was focussed on taking tuition classes for the poor students from Saradha Vidhyalaya Hr sec. school, Burkit Road, T.Nagar. The subjects handled were, Tamil, English and Maths. We were keen on getting efficient people. Professors, and teachers handling higher secondary classes were contacted. They accepted willingly.

Bhagawan has chosen us as instruments in carrying out His mission. Our organisation provides a platform for service activities. Scribing gives the mahilas an opportunity to thank their parents who gave them proper education. Everything happens as per His divine will. His moving hand writes.

We are at a loss for finding words to thank our beloved Bhagawan. I thank Sai Brinda for giving me this opportunity to share my views with others.

World Environment Day Celebrations (Maha Nagar Sankirtan, Sai Sahasranamam & Planting of Tree Saplings)


Maha Nagar Sankirtan




Tree Planting Seva

This is a seamless program spanning across our country, facilitating self-audit in our spiritual journey, with benchmarks from our Lord's own discourses, in His own words.



Directions from the Divine on Seva



Sevā Rendered to Every Living Being Is Sādhanā: (19 November 1981, Sevadal Conference)

The Lord sets the example for the devotees to follow. He teaches that service done to any living being is offered to Him only and is accepted by Him most joyfully. Service rendered to cattle, to beasts, to human beings is laudable sādhanā (spiritual discipline). Keeping the environment of our residences clean, providing help to those who live around the place, going to hospitals and serving the patients who are in the wards—in such acts of service the members of Sri Sathya Seva Organisations must take an active part. Many do such things now as "social service", not as a sādhanā in a full-hearted manner. The sādhanā spirit is not found in the activity.

Through sevā sādhanā, Hanuman attained identity with Rama, as the river attains identity with the sea. Arjuna too considered every act as sādhanā to attain the grace of Krishna, for Krishna directed him to fight on, ever keeping Him in memory—"Māmanusmara yuddhyacha". You too should keep God ever in your mind as the pacesetter, whether you are serving patients in the hospitals or cleaning a drain in the bazaar. That is the tapas (penance). That is the highest form of sādhanā. More than listening to a hundred lectures or delivering them to others, offering one act of genuine sevā attracts the grace of God. The body has to be utilized for service to others. Activity is its main purpose. Krishna says, "I have no need to be engaged in work but I do work in order to set an example for the world". More ānanda can be won by serving others than what can be got by merely serving oneself. Offer service to someone in need, with a full heart, and experience the ānanda that results. It need not be something big. It can be small and unnoticed by others. It has to be done to please the God within you and within the one, you are serving.
