



Therefore, we must choose the right company at all times!









Swami fulfils every Spiritual yearning!

One Thursday in August, I had just finished decorating the altar at Sundaram, when I felt an intense desire to sing on Swami's birthday. However I knew that my chances were slim, as all the senior bhajan singers would be present.

On 18th of November, it so happened that I got a chance to sing "Dasaratha nandana Sri Ramachandra" during the Sunday bhajans. The bhajan group and many of the devotees appreciated the singing. In my mind, all I thought was that "Swami, all these devotees understand my potential to sing but you don't".

On 22nd of November, a Thursday, once I had finished the altar decorations, I was still crying from my inside asking Swami if he really doesn't want me to sing. Just as I did namaskaram after finishing the decorations, I received a message from one of the brothers from the bhajan group, asking me to sing that same bhajan on Swami's birthday.

The next morning I suddenly lost my voice and prayed to Swami to sing through me. The Sai brother, who was to sing with me, started the bhajan on a scale higher than the usual and only Swami sang through me. Tears of gratitude rolled down my eyes even as we sang. I was also chosen to cut Swami's birthday cake. That day changed my life forever. My intense yearning for Swami totally comes from my Balvikas education, which has transformed me into a Sai Student.

Our Balvikas aunty used to come 15 minutes earlier to set up for the class, so I used to make it a point to reach the class 20 minutes earlier and wait for her as I wanted to sweep the area and help her to arrange Swami's photo, flowers and lamp for the class. I totally admire my Guru, who never got angry even if someone irritated her, instead she used to calmly narrate a moral story relating to the ill behavior.

Today, my greatest inspiration to become a Balvikas guru is my Guru.

I still remember an incident that happened once in our samithi when, during my 12th std, on a Narayanaseva day, we were distributing a mango along with curd rice and chips. It was all over and each one of us (members) were given 2 mangoes as there were many and we were vacating the place when suddenly a man in ragged clothes came there and requested for food. But he was asked to go, as everything was over. But I rushed inside the room and picked my 2 mangoes and handed it to him.

This was how balvikas moulded me even from my school days.

During my balvikas days, during an annual day, I was awarded with "The Best Student" award. The main considerations for the award was based on

punctuality, regular attendance for Nagarsankeertan, Narayanaseva, Gramaseva and Bhajans. Thanks to my Mother and Guru who always inspired me.
