

Interestingly, Balvikas Children from the three groups viz., Group - I/II/III participated enthusiastically in these "Festivals of joy" as they showcased their other areas of skills in singing, dancing and acting. Every festival of joy turned out to be a successful one with the colourful participation of kids and their parents.

The regular holding of events at the District level gave us a kind of confidence and belief in us as we were blessed by HIM to fulfill our lifetime dream of offering "Festival of Joy" in the immediate Divine presence at Puttaparthi, in October 2005. As many as 16 BV students across the District were given the chance to represent in the dance drama from Tamilnadu. We could still hold the joy and satisfaction to make our Bhagawan happy as HE blessed all the participating Balvikas kids and Gurus profusely.

Another important event that still lingers in our minds was the staging of the dance drama "Skanda Vaibhavam" at Puttaparthi in 2015. 180 students took part from all over Tamil Nadu and delighted devotees with their amazing dancing skills. I was asked to take charge of Chennai Metro students. I am indebted to Swami for the grand success of the event and my loving core Guru members Smt. Vimala / Smt. Priya Sridhar made the huge tasks simple.

Our Chennai Metro was given another dance program titled as "Krishna Ganam" at Puttaparthi in January 2017 during Balvikas Convocation and Alumni meet. Chennai West was also blessed by Swami to conduct two State level Talent Search competitions for Balvikas Students.

With abundant grace from Swami and the support of elders at home, I was able to accomplish the tasks entrusted to me. My Mother-in-law, Smt. Thulasi Bai has been a pillar of support and inspiration for me in all my Seva activities.

The fact that Balvikas bring about transformation in a child's life is practically seen in day-to-day life. I wish to narrate the transformational attitude of a BV student, in the interest of SAI BRINDA readers.

One boy by name Ranjith Kumar, a Balvikas student, who unfortunately lost both parents was brought to me by his grandmother with the request to find his admission in any school. I got him an admission in Sai school, Chrompet where he finished IX and X standards. Then continuing in Erode Sai School, he successfully finished school education and graduated in Sathyabama Engineering college with the aid of a scholarship and now looking for a job. When I asked him about his future plans after getting a job, he said "I will provide education to an orphan like me". What words of wisdom. This is only due to the value-oriented education that he was imparted during his formative golden period as a SAI BALVIKAS STUDENT..

This change in the attitude of parents should be well utilized by the Gurus and other members in our Organization to create a new generation of Balvikas students who will become torchbearers of Swami's message of Love and peace.

The previous issues of Sanathana Sarathi were distributed to the participants to step up its subscription.




Vilakku Pooja by Kodambakkam Samithi




Of the 565 children who attended the camp, 276 children joined the Balvikas. Two Balvikas Centers were opened by Krishnapuram Samithi & Nungambakkam Samithi in addition to a residential Balvikas Center at Shreya School by Kodambakkam Samithi.

- The fifth session of Prema Pravaham was held on September 1st. The response for this session especially from the parents has been heart warming.
- · Group III Intensive Training Plans to conduct this program on 2nd & 4th Saturday were also proposed.
- · With the objective of enabling the participation of Balvikas children in the National Narayana Seva, a schedule was drawn allotting the dates for different Samithis in the District for this Seva. SPECIAL ARTICLE A Tribute to Soundarya Aunty

"Install the lord in your heart and offer him the fruit of your actions and the flowers of your inner thoughts and feelings. This is the worship I like most the devotion I appreciate most" - Baba



Smt. Soundarya Krishnamoorthy fondly and respectfully called Soundarya aunty was, for our Organization a priceless treasure chest. She was an ideal example of a true devotee of Swami, whose devotion conformed fully to His expectations.

Before embarking on any activity, she would test it deep within against the touchstone of Swami's declared preferences. Just before she shed her mortal coil she said, "I am proceeding towards Swami and wrote "Sairam" on a piece of paper, even as she breathed her last. Her whole being was suffused with this deep devotion, otherwise, the curtains could not have come down in this manner on her earthly sojourn. When she was in the presence of Swami whatever be the occasion, however large the jostling crowds, swami never failed to have a word with her such was their relationship and bonding between her and Swami.

Her family's association with Swami dates back to HIS previous incarnation as Shirdi Sai. Her paternal grandmother had spent many days with Shirdi Sai.

She completed her L.L.B course and enrolled in the Chennai Bar Council. However, she found herself not inclined to pursue a legal career. Instead, she dedicated herself to serve at the Lotus Feet of Bhagawan. She was the State Spiritual Coordinator for many years and had been instrumental in the growth of SSSSO, to a larger extent.

She was a strict disciplinarian forthright in her outlook and speech and had no mental reservations in being articulate. She left no stone unturned for HIS mission. Her passion for perfection was reflected at times as intolerance toward the violation of norms and lack of discipline. Yet the undercurrent of love in her interactions was quite evident. Her moral courage knew no fear, in upholding values and principles.

She would strive tirelessly with that singular force of concentration in serving Swami. To her is due the credit for toiling day and night in the recording theatres to bring out 60 cassettes of Sundaram bhajans. The discipline and decorum maintained by the Sundaram bhajan singers are to be attributed to her. She has put up more than 40 plays by the Balvikas children, at Prashanthi Nilayam in the Divine presence of Swami. Every play was an experience by itself, preparation for the play would begin, well in advance in the month of June for the event to be held in November. Selecting a devotional theme for the play, deep study of the materials related to the subject, writing of dialogues, training the children in acting and effective dialogue delivery, music, recording, costumes, make-up, stage settings, etc. Every aspect of the program was planned by her meticulously to ensure that the same would be in accordance with the expectations of the Divine Master and win HIS approbation. She inculcated values in the children, especially the need to be disciplined and following the dress codes. Children adored her. These cultural programs were beneficial in many ways. Swami interacted with all the participants prior to the staging of the play. To some, HE gave away gifts which HE materialized in their presence. Due to her unrelenting perseverance, Swami cancelled HIS Joola program on one occasion in which Smt. M. S. Subulakshmi was to sing and had the play on

"Azhwars" from Tamil Nadu staged that day. Yet another play on the "Ashtalakshmis" was enacted after four years, about which much an essay can be penned by itself. Celebrating Mahilas Day on March 19th is in vogue only in Tamil Nadu on account of her initiative. Yet another service! She was honoured with the Life Time Achievement award at Parthi and at Chennai at the SLBTS meet.

She started the Bhajan Vikas programme for the Balvikas students, encompassing different Sadhanas for them. An old age home was also run under her guidance for five years.

The Vocational Training Centre was started with the wholehearted concurrence of her entire family desirous of championing this noble cause. The center was inaugurated after she went in person and sought the blessings of Bhagawan. If this center is appreciated by all for its services to the Mahila for more than two decades, the credit goes to Shri T.G. Krishnamoorthy uncle and Smt. Soundarya aunty the prime movers. To them, our gratitude. The last words spoken by her were about V.T.C. - "The responsibility for fostering the growth of V.T.C. and expanding its reach rests with you mahilas". Her blessings coupled with the unstinted cooperation of every member would certainly pave the way for the center to spread its branches far and wide. Our grateful thanks to this devoted couple for having given us an ideal place in the heart of the city to construct a spacious bhajan Hall - Sai Pushpanjali for the West District of our Organization which serves as the venue for many important events.

In short, the term Soundarya connotes beauty. Aunty's magnetic personality did radiate the glow within the inner recesses of her heart, for her love for Swami was fathomless. To her, Swami was more than a mother and dearer than her very life. Her innate aesthetic sense, eye for that elegant touch, and zeal for artistic approach characterized all her pursuits.

She believed in spreading goodwill and cheer and wanted everyone to be donned in bright attire and to forge ahead happily on the path of our beloved Bhagawan.

The performance of the youthful team at Bhagawan's altar was well received and appreciated.




Sadhana Shibir of DPs, SLOBs & NLOBs

DIRECTIONS FROM THE DIVINE ON SEVA



Avoid the ego marring your sadhana

We require today those who take delight in selfless service, but such men are rarely seen. You who belong to Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organization, every one of you, must become a Sevak (servant), eager to help those who need it. When the Sevak becomes the nāyak (leader) the world will prosper. Only a Kinkara (servant) can grow into a Shankara (master). Of course, one has to eliminate the ego totally. Even a trace of it will bring disaster. However long you may do Dhyana, however constant your Japa (recitation), a little ego will render them barren of results. Bhajan done with egoistic pride will be as harsh as the crow's caw. So, try to avoid the ego marring your sadhana, even to a small extent.

You all know the story of sage Vishwamitra, who had as a result of severe tapas (penance) for years, earned the power even to create another Heaven amenable to his will. His ego made him intensely passionate and short-tempered (rājasik). So, he was known as Rāja-yogi and Rājarishi. He was jealous of the sage Vasishta who was adored as a Brahmarishi and sought that title for himself. This made him even more rājasik. The wilder his desire, the higher rose the ego flames.
