Bhagawan's guidance - a beacon through life

To have had the privilege of being with Bhagawan from one's infancy puts a great spiritual responsibility on any one who claims to be HIS devotee. I do believe that HE brought me up, for there is not a facet of my life, which has not been influenced by some specific instruction from HIM or an experience that HE has given. Therefore, I place with all humility at HIS feet the following as a sharing with other fellow devotees my understanding of some of the wonderful instructions Bhagawan has given.

Having lost my father at the early age of 4, my recollections of childhood center around the care, warmth and guidance of my 'Divine Father' Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba. The memories of HIS guidance at every step of my life are so strong and alive that, as they flash by, I am forced to introspect and conclude that each lesson has taught me spiritual values which have sustained me well into adulthood and helped me strive for perfection in my life.

Seated among a group of children, lucky enough to be staying with Bhagawan at Brindavan, one summer evening in the 60's, I recall that each one of us stretched out our hand asking HIM for a sweet of our choice - which of course Bhagawan was graciously materializing and giving. Not for a moment did any one of us look upon it as a 'miracle', for in the eyes of a child 'Baba' can do anything. I wish we adults had that same, unquestioning child like faith in HIS Divinity. When my turn came, child that I was, I also asked for my favorite sweet, only to receive in response from Bhagawan, an utterly serious look and the words, "I am GOD and I am asking you for what you want and you are asking me for a sweet? Ask Maya, only for Grace and Bhakti." That was my sweet. How profound the lesson! We all go to the Giver of the greatest gift man can ask for i.e salvation and instead of asking HIM for 'it' we ask HIM for all the trivial things of this world. Each small materialistic desire, when fulfilled, takes our focus away from the spiritual path.

HE patiently gives, but is waiting for all of us to ask for what HE has come to give; what HE is eager to give and what very few of us ask HIM for.

Catching me quite unawares the same summer Bhagawan just looked at me and said, "Maya, make your second thought your first thought". At the time perhaps, I was too young to understand the full import of the statement, but as the years and life's experiences have gone by, it has dawned on me with utmost clarity that in our day to day life, we tend to react to a situation and invariably" on second thoughts," regret our actions. Bhagawan's guidance was that the second thought always comes after 'thinking' and leads us to take a more appropriate, mature and thoughtful reaction to the problem on hand.

For many, many of us giving Bhagawan a letter, is mostly an outpouring of our trials and tribulations in life or else requests and pleadings for solutions, and prayers seeking blessings for success in our worldly ventures. It seems to be the most important means of communication with HIM, despite Bhagawan's constant reminders that HE is ever with us and ready to listen to us all the time - Omnipresent and Omniscient. Perhaps it was the truth of the latter that HE wished me to imbibe in my relationship with HIM.

Influenced by my peers, as a young girl, I extended only once a 'letter' to Bhagawan. Pat came HIS rejoinder. "Do you think I need to be told by your letter? I don't ever want to see a letter in your hand. When you have something to tell me, sit in your shrine or talk to me where ever you are and I will get your message then and there".

Since then I have had no occasion to disobey HIM, for HE kept HIS words. Not even when faced with the anxiety of my son's accident, my husband's illness, the death of my mother, misfortunes in the family business, or personal financial losses, did I need to do more than talk to him, from wherever I was. Bhagawan, each time, responded almost before the message was conveyed and has helped me out of every situation lovingly, graciously and compassionately.

Having once taken HIS name and accepted HIM as our God -DO WE NEED TO FEAR?

Fifteen years ago, Bhagawan taught me the next step "Maya- mauna-bodha- silent communication". Not a word uttered in all these years, but minute to minute guidance, care and concern showered upon me. I know and HE knows.

Being brought up with brothers and, perhaps, reflecting my own view point in life, I once dared to refuse Bhagawan HIS request to make garlands, brushing it off as "girls" work. Bhagawan laughingly taunted me, "What is girls' work and boys' work? All is human work. All is God's work". Not only did HE insist that I do it, but appreciated me when I eventually succeeded.

Today with my varied responsibilities, as a house wife, mother and grandmother, story writer, value educator, coordinator of a national level parenting program and a full time Secretary of a large service organization dedicated to care, education, health and rehabilitation of orphaned children, any success in my endeavours and initiatives I attribute entirely to Bhagawan's unstinting love and spiritual guidance and personal interactions.

If all work is God's work, then surely any work that leads to SAI is HIS.

Any work involving Service + Adoration + Intellectual study Seva + Bhakti + Gyanam Or Self Analysis and Introspection - leads to HIM

Wherever SAI's teachings are being followed, wherever Divinity is being adored and wherever the Lord is being served and given succor in the Human form, SAI is there. Let none of us dare to limit HIM to just 'Sathya Sai Baba of Puttaparthi'

RAMAKATHA RASA VAHINI PARAYANAM


T. Nagar Samithi


