

Headstart - Empowering the Students with Soft Skills and Software Basics by Vadapalani Samithi



Students from Vadapalani Matriculation Higher Secondary School from classes 8 and 9 are blessed to participate in a pilot project for developing their soft skills and software basics - coding C-Sharp and Python.

Members of Vadapalani Samithi have embarked on a unique pilot program for Vadapalani Matriculation Higher Secondary School. This novel program comprises of teaching both Soft Skills & Software Languages to class 8 and 9 students as envisaged by the School Management.

The following aspects of developing management skills are taught for a couple of hours in the weekend.

- 1. Effective Communication & Presentation Skills
- 2. How to organize oneself
- 3. Time Management
- 4. Problem Solving & Analytical Abilities
- 5. Teamwork & being a team player
- 6. How to Learn Effectively and Improve Knowledge
- 7. How to face exams & come out successfully
- 8. Managing Stress

Software Language Modules taught include C Sharp & Python both theory and practicals by qualified professionals from Infosys, HCL & Zoho etc with the objective of empowering the students for a bright future.

This course is planned to be conducted for nearly 12 to 16 weeks and is bound to benefit in myriad ways more so in the present computer age.


42nd Anniversary Celebrations of Sundaram
