The above sloka is the life story of many caterpillars that metamorphosed to beautiful butterflies, ugly ducklings that were transformed to Royal Swans and that of street dogs becoming 'Street Lamps' (as lovingly mentioned by our beloved Swami in HIS last interview to me as a Sai Student) by the Divine Alchemist - our Swami. HE is the alchemist in whose hands, not just any metal or rock, but even garbage turns into gold.

As the glory of our Lord cannot be penned down even with the whole Earth as the paper and the oceans as ink, I would just narrate a few incidents in my life that are but micro droplets of HIS Mercy, Compassion, Love and Glory.

Our family came into Swami's fold in the early 1970s and as is the custom in a Sai family, I and my sister were sent to Balvikas classes and we grew up nicely as Balvikas students. Mine was 'Love at first sight' with Swami, when we had a Divine Dharshan of Swami during our stay in Salem.

As a family we prayed together and attended various Sai Satsangs and were progressing steadily in Sai spirituality and I was also growing comfortably to the liking of my parents. But, that was when fate did a jig with me. When we moved to Madras on my father's Office transfer, my bad association in my school days set a lot of bad trends in me to the discomfort of my parents. Though, I was engaged in abhorrent behaviour, still my love for Swami was not lost (Our beloved Swami said that "Once you come to me, I shall never leave you go, though you may try to leave me")

Inspite of my life filled with unpalatable activities from Monday to Fridays, I was a regular Balvikas attendee held on Saturdays and was a regular participant in most of the Seva activities!!!!. Interestingly, on Sundays I was also attending Bhajan Sessions at Sundaram. Similar to the storylines of 'Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde', to say the least.

Ever since the darshan of the Lord Supreme, we as a family had the habit of visiting Prasanthi Nilayam at least once in a year, to seek HIS Dharshan. As a youngster with loadful of flaws, I was dumbstruck to watch the joyful conversations between Swamy and HIS students. The deep love and compassion for Swami that ensured the necessary freedom and confidence in HIS students, impressed me a lot to an extent that I was yearning to become one of HIS students!!!!. I used to stand in front of a mirror wearing white dress rehearsing myself to become Swami's student. Each passing day, the SAI fire in me was engulfing me so much that my innermost love for Swami was also peaking steadily, yet I was not attempting to give up my bad company!!!

After the State Board 10th Grade Public Examination, confidentially I applied for 11th Grade Swami's School securing admission and I did not care to send my application to any other Schools. Do or die situation, either continue my higher education in HIS Schools or to remain as an 11th Grade School drop-out...

We went to Prasanthi Nilayam and decided to remain in Puttaparthy, till my admission. In between the Dharshan times, I was nervous of my selection as my mind quickly analysed the pluses and minuses in me. The mind in me admitted that I had no good conduct, poor skills, low talents and bad academics and the person in me suggested to me that my aims of becoming HIS student would become a heavy flop. I was heavily banking upon the grant of Swami's motherly compassion and grace for my love to Swami and prayers to HIM. In one of the Dharshan sessions by HIS Sankalpa, the wavering mind in me settled to a thought that the admission in HIS School could be made easily possible, by winning HIS GRACE alone.

But, the big question mark was how to win HIS GRACE? My inner heart said that I have to atone for my sins seriously and at the same time make serious attempts to gain entry into HIS Heart by the power of your sincere prayers. I wrote a letter to Swami saying that of course I was the most despicable creature to be found in HIS creation, yet I had no refuge other than HIM. I prostrated at HIS Feet confessing that my studentship in HIS School alone would transform me into a better person to HIS liking.

As for atoning the countless sins in my life, I thought I should seize Seva opportunities in Prashanti Nilayam. Fortunately, I was given the chance to do toilet cleaning Seva near the Ganesh shed. The Seva regime was interesting as we woke up early in the morning to clean the toilets, then take bath to rush for HIS Darshan. The same was followed for the evening session also and before taking our dinner, we were happy to clean the toilets one more time. By Swami's grace, I was fortunate to have HIS darshan sitting in the First row, first person carrying a handwritten love letter addressed to HIM anticipating HIS acceptance. My conviction was that if the letter was received by Swami, I was secured of my 11th Grade admission in HIS School.

The letter was held by me for more than 25 days, waiting for HIS nod. Swami was reaching the person sat next to me and would be looking thru' me. The wait game was too much for me to comprehend as HIS leelas are beyond human miniscule understanding. It pained me so deeply that during every Darshan, I was terribly crying out to Swami. But, all in vain!

With that, I wrote the entrance examination nervously and fared very poorly in the interviews that followed the written tests. The same evening, I sat in the first row tears streaming all over my cheeks with suppressed sobs waiting for HIS darshan.

When Swami came gliding by; my heart was in my mouth as I extended my hand desperately to Swami with the age-old letter with sticking plasters for the torn at the ends. My heart skipped a beat or two and remained motionless as Swami came straight to me and took the letter from me in HIS right index and middle fingers (later on someone indicated to me that my bad KARMAS were cut-off by HIM by scissor like receipt). Instantly, I was relieved and my heart felt that I would get admission in HIS school.

Next day, my name was found in the very second line, indicating that I was the Second rank-holder. I trembled and fainted with joy.

I wish to recollect that the entrance examinations were conducted for English and Mathematics. Few days before the entrance examination, Swami instructed the School to conduct the tests only for English subjects. All Knowing Swami would be knowing my predicaments in Mathematics subject. Had there been a Maths paper required for selection, I would have surely failed... Looking back, presume our Dear Lord would have scrapped mathematics for the sake of poor soul like me.

New environment, fresh air, same body and mind in me.. The beauty of Prasanthi Nilayam is TRANSFORMATION.. I was transforming regularly and at rapid speed also. The atmosphere and the good company influenced me a lot. My bad thoughts got clipped one by one, soothing words began and my actions were becoming more decent.

Let me share a few of my personal Sai Student Moments with Swami -

On the eve of Swami's 59th Birthdays celebrations in 1984, we wanted to stage an acrobatic show for HIM. I was a part of the Team. During morning practice session, a student suddenly came running from the Mandir saying that Swami was calling Rajagopal from Madras. I thought it was a case of mistaken identity and Swami must have called Rajkumar Jain (Form boy) and not me. Still, I was hurrying myself after the ablutions to the call of my Master.

By the time we reached, Swami had taken all the devotees inside the interview room and closed the door. The warden (Mr.B.N.Narasimhamurthy then) told us - "Hard luck boys! Once Swami closes the interview room he doesn't open it". Before he could complete the sentence, to our surprise the interview room door opened. Swami called out "Hey! Madras Rowdy! Come in". Without hesitation, I rushed in and was seated on HIS right side and HIS left side was already occupied by another student. I was in total awe! Swami gave both of us a private audience. After HIS initial inquiries about hostel/food/studies etc. HE warned the other student for his bad behaviour at home. Obviously, his eyes were filled with tears. Then Swami patted him and consoled him. As I was nervously witnessing the scenes, Swami started "CHEE! What sort of human being you are!", and as Swami continued, I realised how low I had fallen! I couldn't look at Swami's face as I bent my head down and poured a bountiful of tears to fall on Swami's Lotus feet. Suddenly, an orange sleeved hand appeared under my face, and Swami put HIS fingertips under my chin and lifted my face up. I was taken aback, because Swami was leaning so close to me as I could view the reflection of myself in the pupils of HIS eyes. Then Swami said "Past is past. Future is not in your hands. Live the present in a wholesome manner."

Then the Lord did something, which I never expected; he stretched HIS rosy palm of HIS right hand and told me," Promise me that you won't ever step into that path again!" I lifted my hand thinking what if I broke the promise submitted to the Lord of the Universe. As I was beginning to lift my hand, in a trice the Lord HIMSELF suddenly pressed my hand on HIS left hand and quipped "See! You promised!" and flashed a smile as pure as that of an infant!

The "Promise to Swami" still guards me against worldly temptations and the 'two rosy orange sleeved hands' protect me from succumbing to other earthly pursuits. promise stood me in great stead during my later years as the temptations of the world weSuch is the power of the Divine Alchemist!

By Swami's grace, I showed keen interest in playing tabla and fine-tuned my passion to become a part of Prasanthi Mandir Bhajan Group. One day, when I was playing the tabla I had forgotten to open the cap of Ponds powder tin (powder is being used by the tabla-players to prevent sweating of the palms and for lubrication of movement) When I opened the powder tin lid, to my horror, the cap shot up like a bullet upwards and was descending on Swami's head! My heart was in my mouth! Swami was sitting with HIS eyes closed! But, unbelievably the cap changed its trajectory and made an impossible outward curve and fell on the left side of HIS footstool! After the end of Bhajan and Aarthi to Swami, before leaving the Hall, Swami saw the cap and looked at me mischievously, stepped over the cap and went on to the interview room! The incident reminded me that our Mother Sai was ALL KNOWING - Omnipresent, Omnipotent and Omniscient - controlling the movement of the animate and inanimate.

In the year 1989-90, Swami wanted to hold a 'Kavi Sammelan' (poems praising the Lord) programme to be staged exclusively by HIS students. We, the eagerful students, collected popular poems written by great poets in various languages and presented the same to Swami. Swami saw our presentation at least 3 to 4 times and also gave HIS approval. But, on the morning of the programme, Swami sent us a word not to present someone else's poem, instead HE expected the efforts of HIS students in composing poems to give proper meaning of the Programme. The Command of the Lord spurred us sufficiently as we all sat with a pen and paper and our mind was fixed on HIM, writing poetry. We were able to pen our thoughts in poem form within 60 minutes. Almost ten boys including me had our first-time real experience in composing our own poetry. I am happy to share that I was able to write a poem in 10 minutes!! tuning took another 10 minutes for the humble offering in front of HIM at Poornachandra Auditorium, attended by more than 1000 participants. After the end of the programme, Swami came on stage and gifted each of us with a shawl. It was made possible by HIS Grace, on the lines of Lord Krishna's message to Arjuna - "Nimittamaatram Bhava Savyasaachin".

In one of HIS Discourses on Bhagavath Geetha in the year 1984, Swami exhorted us that "It is not enough that you say you love God - God must say that you are HIS". That message sank in my heart as I was looking at every single opportunity to please HIM viz., singing well in the Bhajan sessions, playing instruments nicely, excelling in gymnastics, yoga and sports, learning to dance bhangra, sometimes even forgetting food and ignoring sleep or doing something noteworthy to draw the attention of the devotees to hold HIS boys in good esteem.

My intention was that HE should see me in every other programme conducted at Prasanthi Nilayam to say that 'I am HIS'. I was overly obsessed, to say the least.

Though HE saw me in every other programme, still what I wanted from Dear Lord didn't fructify - HE did not say that I was HIS.

Though, Swami tests you thoroughly to the hilt, yet you can win HIS Heart by your patience and perseverance. My day came in January, 1990 on the eve of Annual Sports Day.

In order to draw HIS appreciation, I volunteered to perform a back somersault from a moving motorbike. Many of us would not opt for high-risk adventurism and for fatal injuries. I was stern that I should perform in front of Swami to fulfil my ambition to earn the remarks from swami that - 'I am HIS'.

Even at the last moment of staging somersaults, one of the students backtracked saying "Rajagopal, I don't think I can do this. You do it". With heavy prayers in mind also carrying HIS remarks I moved to the edge of the plank and I looked at Swami to ensure that HE was watching. When the motor bike came, I simply shouted "Jai Sai Ram" and leapt. It was a satisfactory 10/10. As soon as I landed on the ground, I just looked at Swami waiting for HIS approval. To my dismay, Swami was in a deep conversation with a VIP and I thought Swami ignored me again as I considered all my 'stunt act' was in vain

My heart sank when Swami ignored my performance, since I was completing my final year in HIS Institution and that was my last chance to achieve my well nurtured aim - 'I am HIS'. I was so upset with HIM that I didn't even bother to look at HIS face in the photograph session as I preferred standing at a distance from Swami! I skipped lunch.

After the evening darshan, I was just walking alone on the terrace not wanting to look at anyone. I was crying, pleading out to HIM "Why Swami, why? This is my last chance and you have ruined it! You know that I was doing all these activities to please you only, isn't it? Then why did you ignore me even in my last opportunity?"

Just then, one of the brothers attending Swami on the stage, who was also walking on the terrace came to me and said "Rajagopal brother, you are the luckiest one today". I didn't understand the sudden conversation. I retorted at him "Why?". He said coolly, "When your stunt act was done, immediately Swami asked the VIP, "How was the stunt?". The VIP exclaimed "Amazing Swami!". Then, Swami proudly remarked thus - "Vaadu evvadu thelusa? Naavadu!" (You know who that Boy is? He is MY Boy!)

I felt like slapping myself! We are so engrossed in what we are doing and we are so centered only in our selfishness that we miss out God's message altogether! I ran to the ground, lay down on the stage at the very place where Swami sat and cried my heart out to HIM, to pardon me.

I learnt that HE is not impressed in what you do or deem to do; the Dear Lord is very easily moved by the feeling of your acts you undertake and by your intentions (bhava).

Then came the time for me to leave the portals of the Sacred Institution! I was blessed by Swami by a personal interview. At the end of the interview, the Lord said, "Do you remember how you came here? You came here as a street dog. I have made you a street lamp. Now Go! Whatever is given to you is to be shared with everyone with humility and devotion. Swami is always with you." With these magical words ringing in my ears, I left the Holy Abode of the Lord.

I visited Prasanthi Nilayam many times, till the Lord was there in the physical form. Even after, HE left HIS physical frame I am being constantly reminded that I should not confine HIM to HIS five-feet structure, but to act as a STREET LAMP spreading HIS Mission to the best of my efforts and understanding.

As a Sai Student (HIS property), I am confident of my success in my attempts purely by HIS unfathomable Grace, Compassion and Mercy - for HE is the Lord who looks for an excuse to grant rather than to withhold.



### **DIRECTIONS FROM THE DIVINE ON SEVA**



#### **TRUE SEVA**

Seva is a small word but is filled with immense spiritual significance. Hanuman is the supreme exemplar of the ideal of service. When the Rakshasas asked Hanuman, during his search for Sita in Lanka, who he was, he replied simply: "Dasoham Kosalen-drasya." He was content to describe himself as the humble servant of Rama. Seva must be viewed as the highest form of sadhana Serving the poor in the villages is the best form of sadhana. In the various forms of worship of the Divine, culminating in Atma-nivedanam (complete surrender to the Divine), Seva comes before Atmanivedanamam. God's grace will come when Seva is done without expectation of reward or recognition. Sometimes Ahamkaram (ego) and Abhirnanam (attachment) rear their heads during Seva. These should be eliminated altogether.
