Pooja Stores

The setup of the Pooja Stores commenced on 7th February 2025 with a dedicated team of six youth volunteers from Chennai arriving in Puttaparthi first time for seva. Their first task was to segregate and transport the bulk quantities of pooja and Homam materials from Shed No. 33 to Pandit Hall and East Prashanthi A8 using local transport facilities. Seva began at 7:00 PM and continued until 2:00 AM, demonstrating the commitment and dedication of the volunteers.
