#### 1. Tamil New Years Day Celebration at Prashanti Nilayam

- **Medical & Welfare Seva – Community Care at Chinna Vannan Kuppam**

- **Compassionate Summer Outreach – Buttermilk Seva**  
As part of Summer Sadhana, devotees of Ashok Nagar Samithi have been consistently conducting weekly buttermilk distribution since 22nd March 2026. Members, Bal Vikas parents, and devotees actively participated in preparing and distributing buttermilk at designated seva points, offering refreshment and relief to the public during the peak summer heat.
