Spiritual Wing Activities

1. Sundaram Samashti Upanayanam celebrations

The Samashti Upanayanam was conducted on 2 days (19th and 20th of Feb) at Sundaram in a grand manner. Around 55 Vatus with their families participated in the Upanayanam function. On Thursday evening the Poorvangam rituals were held. The Brahmopadesham was held on Friday morning. Around 1000 devotees participated in the function.



2. Maha Shivaratri

The Maha Shivaratri was celebrated across all centres in TN North. At Sundaram there was Ekadhasa Rudra Parayanam and bhajans from 6 p.m. till 6 a.m. Shivaratri was celebrated at Sai Nivas, Sai Pushpanajali, Sai Charanam, Sai Kendra Sholinganallur, Sai Krishna Puducherry and other district centres.

3. Chennai West

• Kumbhabhishekam at Adopted Village – Chinna Vannam Kuppam

On 1st February 2026, the district successfully organized the Kumbhabhishekam of the renovated Sri Ganesh Temple at Chinna Vannam Kuppam, its adopted village. The ceremony was held on the auspicious day of Thai Poosam and Pournami, with sacred rituals performed by Sri Veda Srinivasan and his team of Ritwiks. Beginning at 4:30 a.m. with preparatory work and culminating at 7:30 a.m., the event was marked by devotion, discipline, and collective participation.

From an impact perspective, the inclusion of village trustees in the Sankalpam proceedings symbolized shared responsibility and collective prayer for the welfare of the villagers, their crops, and livestock. This reinforced the integration of spiritual practice with community wellbeing. The distribution of prasadam to more than 400 villagers ensured inclusivity and strengthened social bonds, while the rejuvenation of the temple created a renewed spiritual hub for the community.

- **Thai Velli Vilakku Pooja**

On 6th February 2026, the Chennai West District organized the Thai Velli Thiruvilakku Pooja across all 17 Samithis, reinforcing spiritual unity and the wellbeing of society. To encourage wider public participation, most Samithis conducted the Pooja at nearby temples, thereby extending the blessings of the ritual to the community at large. The T. Nagar Samithi held the program at RKM Saradha Vidyalaya School, engaging students, teachers, and parents, while the Ashoknagar Samithi utilized the occasion to share Divine Messages and highlight the Seva activities of the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organization, inspiring the public towards value-based living. The event witnessed active participation from 244 Mahilas, 34 Bal Vikas children, 28 parents and teachers, along with members of the public.



- **Maha Shivaratri Akhanda Bhajans**

Maha Shivaratri was celebrated with great fervor at Sai Pushpanjali, the District Hall of Chennai West, commencing with Rudrabhishekam to Sri Sai Chandra Mauleeswarar at 3:30 p.m. on 15th February 2026. The program was enriched by devotional offerings from Bal Vikas children, with 35 boys and 45 girls reciting Bilvashtakam and Lingashtakam, while Mahilas and youth girls rendered Nirvana Shatakam and Nataraja Dashakam. Youth boys and girls further elevated the spiritual atmosphere by presenting Arunachala Akshara Manamala. A profound spiritual discourse on Advaita philosophy in the divine form of Lord Shiva was delivered by Sister Vimala Ramesh, deepening the participants' understanding of the significance of Shivaratri.

At 6:00 p.m., the Lamp of Love was lit, marking the commencement of Akhanda Bhajans offered by Bal Vikas children, youth, Mahilas, and gents from all 17 Samithis. The celebrations witnessed remarkable participation, with around 100 Bal Vikas children, 30 parents, 28 youth, 150 Mahilas, and 90 gents joining in the collective prayer. The devotion continued through the night, concluding with Maha Mangala Aarathi at 6:00 a.m. on 16th February 2026. On the same day, Bharatidasan Colony celebrated Shivaratri at their community hall, beginning with Veda chanting
