Spiritual Wing Activities

1. Chennai North

- June 28 – Ekadasha Rudra Parayanam at RBI Samithi.

2. Chennai East Coast

- Mahilas day celebrations on 19th June 2026 – Sai Sahasranama Archana at all Samithis

3. Mayiladuthurai

- We conducted a **Sadhana Camp** on the theme "**Back to Basics**" preliminary at **Thirunagari Samithi** on 28.06.2026 as a continuation of the **Back-to-Basics** training programme held in Chennai. During the camp, our office bearers revisited and explained the fundamental principles, values, objectives, and organisational structure to all the participants. Around **56 members** from across the district, particularly Samithi Convenors and office bearers, participated in the camp. The programme strengthened the participants' understanding of the organisation's core ideals and enhanced their commitment to carrying forward its mission effectively.



- Members of the Samithis collectively chanted Gayathri mantra 1008 times at the following temples –Velvidainathar Temple, Thirukarukavur on 17th June 2026, Naganathasamy temple Semmangudi on 24th June 2026.

Service Wing Activities

11. Chennai West:

- **Summer Skill Development Program – Vocational & Life Skills Training**
With Swami's divine grace, the Sri Sathya Sai Skill Development Centre, T. Nagar, successfully conducted its annual Summer Skill Development Program in June 2026, offering vocational and life skills training to school and college students. Six participants completed courses in Wire Basket Making, Sambraani Making, Thiri Making, Typing, Conversational English, and Yoga, and received certificates from District Spiritual Coordinator Smt. Vasugi Sairam, who inspired them with guidance on discipline, responsibility, and strengthening their connection with Swami. The



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program also integrated service activities such as cake packing for Tamil New Year celebrations at Prasanthi Nilayam and cleaning seva at Sai Pushpanjali, thereby combining skill development with character building and selfless service. By nurturing confidence, self-reliance, and a spirit of seva, the initiative advanced organisational goals of youth empowerment, value-based living, and continuity of service, as students expressed their willingness to participate in future activities of the Sai Organisation.

- **Newborn Baby Kit Distribution – Mother & Child Care Seva**

By Bhagawan's grace, K.K. Nagar Samithi distributed 12 Newborn Baby Kits at Chinna Porur Government Hospital on 4 June 2026, supporting the care and well-being of newborn babies and their mothers. The seva was carried out smoothly with the wholehearted support of hospital authorities and reflected Swami's message of "Love All, Serve All." The thoughtfully prepared kits contained essential items for the initial care of both mother and child, bringing comfort to beneficiaries and offering devotees another opportunity to express selfless love through service.



- **Reflexology Workshop – Healthy Living Through Simple Techniques**

The Sri Sathya Sai Skill Development Centre organised a practical Reflexology Workshop for members of West Mambalam Samithi in June 2026. Conducted by experienced trainer Sri Balasubramanian, the session introduced participants to simple reflexology techniques and exercises for maintaining a healthy lifestyle. Around 30 members actively engaged in the demonstrations and appreciated the practical nature of the program, which highlighted the importance of preventive healthcare and adopting simple daily practices for physical well-being.



- **Goshala Seva – Sacred Service with Love and Devotion**

With Swami's divine grace, youth members from Sowrashtra Nagar Bhajana Mandali and Krishnapuram Samithi, along with devotees from neighbouring Samithis and Sri Sathya Sai Students Alumni, participated in Goshala Seva at West Mambalam in June 2026.



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12. Chennai North:

- 100 kg of Sai Protein given every month to neonatal mothers for the past one and a half years and to the cancer ward for the past three months at Govt. Egmore Children's Hospital.

Aari, Japanese N5 classes, CEO exams training, Spoken English, Beautician course, Hindi tuition, Plumbing, Electrician, SQL and Python classes, Tally classes, Yoga classes are being conducted.
- June 27 – Free Cataract Eye Screening camp conducted by Ayanavaram, RBI, Purasaiwalkam, Kilpauk Samithis and Sidco Nagar BM at Purasaiwalkam Annadhana Samajam.
- June 14 - Sri Sathya Sai Tribal Women Health Project survey at Chittankulam -Villayanar Colony.
- June 14 - Free Medical Camp-Every Second Sunday Conducted by Tondiarpet Samithi at Adi Dravida Hostel Tondiarpet.

13. Chennai Southeast:

- Combined Medical Camp along with Thiruvannamiyur Samithi held on Saturday 13th & 27th June 2026 at Sakkarai Amma Temple--Beneficiaries 113, Sevadals participated 13 (7 Gents + 6 Mahilas). Eye Check-up, Free Spectacle, Ortho Check-up & General Check-up provided to the Beneficiaries. For those who needed Cataract Surgery -Free surgery performed at Chettinad Hospital-Kelambakkam.
- Pallikaranai Samithi conducted medical camp on 28 Jun 2026: 73 patients (43 Mahilas, 29 Gents, 2 children), 3 Doctors, Paramedics – 8 (2 Mahilas and 6 Gents), Sevadals – 7 (1 Mahila and 6 Gents), Total new patients – 5, BP check – 40, Sugar check – 35. Total patient registrations crossed 1672. Biscuit Seva – 100 biscuit packets were given. Butter Milk Seva – was conducted every Sunday at 2 centers and about 3500 cups were served overall.

14. Cuddalore:

- Skill development program (Computer, Aari work, Tailoring, Mehandhi designing) has been conducted in Neyveli Sai Samithi and tailoring has been conducted in Chidambaram and Virudhachalam Sai Samithi.
- Medical camp conducted in 4 Samithis



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- Distributed 450 kg Sai protein powder to HIV affected children across Cuddalore district and for pregnant ladies.

15. Tiruvallur East

- Sai protein is regularly distributed in adopted villages for pregnant / lactating women and children.
- A Disaster Management awareness programme was conducted at Devampattu village, Ponneri on 28-Jun-2026. 38 village people participated and benefitted.



16. Chennai East Coast

- Sai Protein powder prepared and distributed by 3 Samithis. Approximately 100+ kgs prepared by Mahilas and distributed to the identified beneficiaries such as pregnant women, lactating mothers, children & elders and TB patients at Semmenchery.
- Snack and Milk seva on all Tuesday and Friday was conducted by Karanai Samithi and Bollineni bhajan Mandali. Total beneficiaries were 65+ children from Semmencherry. Sevadals participated – approx. 18.
- Warm milk, peanut candy, Bananas, and Biscuits were distributed weekly by Sholinganallur Samithi to the economically weaker sections of people.
